The Inspectors and District Clerk verified the voting results as follows:

PROPOSITION #1 – BUDGET ADOPTION

“Shall the Board of Education of the Marcellus Central School District be authorized to expend the sums set forth in the total amount of \$34,392,500 for the 2017-2018 school year and to levy the necessary tax therefore?”

PROPOSITION#2 – PURCHASE OF BUSES

“Shall the Board of Education (“Board”) of the Marcellus Central School District (“District”) be authorized to purchase two (2) 30-passenger school buses at a maximum estimated cost of \$52,071 each, two (2) 30-passenger school buses with wheelchair lift at a maximum estimated cost of \$65,831 each and one (1) 7-passenger van at a maximum estimated cost of \$26,270, for a combined maximum estimated expenditure of \$262,074, and to obtain the necessary funds by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District, to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board shall determine in accordance with Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, to issue up to \$262,074 of obligations of the District?”

PROPOSITION#3 – CAPITAL RESERVE FUND PROPOSITION

“Shall the Board of Education (“Board”) of the Marcellus Central School District (“District”) be authorized to establish a new capital reserve fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 3651 of the Education Law to pay costs of the construction, reconstruction, renovation and equipping of District buildings and other facilities, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings and other incidental improvements in connection therewith, in an ultimate amount of \$5,000,000, having a probable term of ten (10) years and be authorized to raise \$5,000,000 to fund such capital reserve fund in the current or future years through various sources including, but not limited to, state aid reimbursement, cost saving measures resulting in unexpended funds or unappropriated fund balance and other legally available funds of the District?”

PROPOSITION#4 – MARCELLUS FREE LIBRARY BUDGET

“Resolved, that pursuant to Education Law, Section 259, the Board of Education of the Marcellus Central School District is authorized to levy and collect an annual tax, year after year, separate and apart from the annual school budget, in the amount of \$10,062 (in addition to the current annual appropriation of \$503,076 for a total of \$513,138 annually), which shall be paid to the Marcellus Free Library for the support and maintenance of the library, with this appropriated amount to be the annual appropriation until thereafter modified by a future vote of the electors of the Marcellus Central School District.”





